

Barn Rules

CAMPER agrees to abide by all of the MANAGER'S rules and regulations whether verbal or stated in the barn rules.

CAMPER will be given one verbal warning when a rule is broken. If CAMPER breaks the same rule again they will be asked to not participate in any future events. If CAMPER continually breaks rules and does not follow safety guidelines CAMPER will be asked to go home immediately. Any and all fees paid will not be refunded.

1. Smoking is not allowed in the barns,
2. Running or screaming is not appropriate around horses;
3. All equipment should be returned to its place after use;
4. Pick up after your horse and yourself, we are not responsible for items left out;
5. If you turn on something, turn it off, and put it up correctly when finished;
6. Illegal substances are not allowed on property at any time;
7. If you are the last one to leave the barn, it is your responsibility to make sure that the doors are locked and the barn is closed properly;
8. All riders and handlers must have a current signed release of liability form on file in the office;
9. All riders **must wear** an ASTM and SEI approved riding helmet with a properly fastened harness at all times while mounted;
10. You are responsible for any injury or damage that you, your guests, or your animals do;
11. It is recommended that all persons entering the facility or property wear hard soled shoes or boots to prevent accidents
12. No one is to be at the farm before or after the hours of operation, without the express permission of the management, unless there is an emergency;
13. If in doubt please ask the management. Remember to **BE SAFE, BE RESPONSIBLE, and BE RESPECTFUL.**
